PROMULGATION OF ACT OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

The following Act which has been passed by the National Assembly and signed by the President in terms of the Namibian Constitution is hereby published in terms of Article 56 of that Constitution.

ACT

To amend the Attorneys Act, 1979, so as to extend the powers of the council of The Law Society of Namibia in respect of the assessment of fees for work other than litigious work payable to practitioners.

(Signed by the President on 11 August 1993)

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of Namibia, as follows:-

Amendment of section 69 of Act 53 of 1979, as amended by section 23 of Act 87 of 1989 and section 27 of Act 17 of 1991.

1. Section 69 of the Attorneys Act, 1979, is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraph (h) of the following paragraph:

“(h) prescribe the manner of assessment of the fees payable by any person to a practitioner in respect of the performance on behalf of such a person of any work other than litigious work and in respect of expenses reasonably incurred by such practitioner in connection with the performance of that work, and at the request of such person or practitioner or of its own accord, assess such fees in the prescribed manner;”.

Short title.

2. This Act shall be called the Attorneys Amendment Act, 1993.
